- I. Meeting was called to order by President Linda Shirley at 4:10
- II. Minutes from the 11/15/18 meeting submitted by Carolyn Rose were reviewed and accepted (D.Nelson/ V.McMoy)
- III. Treasurer's Report was submitted by Ina Roberts was reviewed and accepted (T.Martin /D.Nelson)
- IV. Highlights from TCBOE meetings:
  - a. 1/28/19 – Ms. Hudgins led a presentation in which she highlighted the World of Works offered to 8<sup>th</sup> graders and up and other programs
  - b. 2/11/19 – Calendar A was approved with 67% of votes. Snow day wavier was approved. CNP Presentation for being recognized in Food Management Magazine for Nutrition Ignition Bus. Presentation by Mr. Dennis Duncan for Career Tech month (February). Financial report was given and emphasis was placed on receipting money daily.
  - c. 2/25/19 – Some TCSS students presented on the Amazing Hand Shake Program they had participated in that included soft skills, interviewing skills, etc. Parents from CRMS spoke about the issues with the gun being found on campus. Greg Hurst was available to record information from parents regarding that issue. Course catalogs were presented. High schools are moving away from the title of “Pre AP” and will now be titled “Honors”. TCSS is adding ½ credit for career prep A (MS) and B (HS). New math course of study is being released March 14.
