- VI. State Board of Education Updates
 - a. 2.5% pay raise
 - b. Education Budget is expecting the Governor's signature by next week
 - c. bill in the works that would allow teachers to be trained to carry a gun, but the local school system could opt out of this
 - d. bill in the works for all superintendents to be appointed instead of elected
- VII. UNISERV UPDATE/ William Tunnell –
 - a. President Shirley recognized William Tunnell for his promotion as Northern Regional Manager
 - b. District 16 Uniserv position is vacant: 12 month, TRS, PEEHIP, will post in the next AEA Journal, most likely a June hire
 - c. Pay attention to Montgomery County – the State has taken over and there are 2 different charter school applications. AEA has filed suit against the charter. There are a series of 5 schools proposed for charter conversion. *Stay alert for updates regarding this topic
